BING by
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Materials needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Glue gun stick
- White felt

Terminology: (UK terms)

slst: Slip stitch
inc: Increase

ch: Chain
dec: Decrease

MR: Magic ring
htr: Half Triple crochet

dc: Double crochet
tr: Triple crochet



Head In Yarn A

1. dc 6 in a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (dc 4, inc) x6 (36)
- 7.(dc 5, inc) x6 (42)
- 8-9. dc around (42) x 2 rounds
10. (dc 6, inc) x6 (48)
11. (dc 7, inc) x6 (54)
- 12-19. dc around (54) x8 rounds
20. (dc 2, dec) x13, dc 2 (41)
21. (dc 1, dec) x13, dc 2 (28)
22. dec x14 (14)
23. dec x7 (7)

Stuff the head, make sure to leave a hole in the stuffing for the glue stick to support the head. **See fig. 1**

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

Legs/Body

Starting in Yarn B, make 2 legs

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 5-13. dc around (24) x9 rounds

Fasten off the first leg here and repeat rounds 1-13 to make the second leg. Keep the second leg on the hook.

14. Get your first leg and connect with a dc, dc 23, connect to the other side with a dc, dc 23 (48). **See fig. 2**
- 15-17. dc around (48) x 3 rounds
18. (dc 6, dec) x6 (42)
19. (dc 5, dec) x6 (36)
20. dc around (36)
21. (dc 4, dec) x6 (30) - Stuff the legs firmly
- 22-26. dc around (30) x5 rounds
27. (dc 3, dec) x6 (24)
- 28-29. dc around (24) x2 rounds
30. (dc 2, dec) x6 (18) - Insert a glue stick into the body here and stuff around it. **See fig. 3**
31. (dc 1, dec) x6 (12)
32. (dc 1, dec) x4 (8)
- 33-34. dc around (8) x 2 rounds

Fasten off leaving a tail making sure about 3cm of the gluestick is above the last round. Attach the body to the head, inserting the 3cm of the gluestick in the gap in the head. **See fig. 4**

Leg Cuffs

In Yarn C, make 2

1. ch 26, dc in 2nd chain from the hook, dc along the chain (25)
2. dc along (25)

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

Sew the cuffs onto the bottom of each leg, on between R 5&9. See fig. 5



Slipper Detail

Cut out 4 small circles in white felt and glue or sew to the front of the feet. See fig. 6

In Yarn E, sew a zigzag just below the eyes

Using a marker, make a dot on each felt circle for the pupil



Arms

Starting in Yarn A, make 2

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. inc into each st around (12)
3. (dc 2, inc) x4 (16)
- 4-6. dc around (16) x3 rounds
7. **Change to Yarn B**, dc around (16)
- 8-14. dc around (16) x7 rounds
15. (dc 2, dec) x4 (12)
- 16-19. dc around (12) x 4 rounds

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.



Arm Cuffs

In Yarn C

1. ch 17, dc in 2nd ch, dc 15 (16)

Fasten off and sew to the arms. See fig. 7

Sew the arms to the top of the body at around round 29. See fig. 8



Zigzag Detail

In Yarn D

Using pins, map out a path around the waist of the body in a zigzag shape. See fig. 9. With a length of yarn D, sew the zigzag pattern onto the body. See fig. 10





Ears

In Yarn A, make 2

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. dc around (6)
3. (dc 1, inc) x3 (9)
4. (dc 2, inc) x3 (12)
5. (dc 3, inc) x3 (15)
6. (dc 4, inc) x3 (18)
- 7-14. dc around (18) x8 rounds
15. (dc 4, dec) x3 (15)
16. (dc 3, dec) x3 (12)
- 17-19. dc around (12) x3 rounds

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Get a strand of Yarn F, sew the detailing of the ears. **See fig. 11.**

Sew onto the top of the head in line with R3 of the head. **See fig. 12**

Big Hair Tuft

In Yarn A

ch 8, dc in 2nd chain from hook, htr 6, (7)

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

Small Hair Tufts

In Yarn A

1. ch 6, slst in the 2nd chain from the hook, htr 4, (5)

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

Arrange the two small tufts on either side of the big one and sew them together. **See fig. 13.** Sew to the top of the head between the ears.

Eyes

Starting in Yarn A, make 2

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. **Change to Yarn E**, (dc 2, inc) x2, dc 1, **change to Yarn A**, dc 1, inc, dc 2, (contd.) dc in next st, **change to Yarn C**, dc in same st (16)
4. (dc 3, inc) x2, dc 3 (11)

Fasten off leaving a white and black strand of yarn attached for sewing.





Mouth

Starting in Yarn G

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. dc 1, dc 3 in next st, dc 2, dc 2 in the next st, **change to Yarn A**, dc in same st (10)
3. dc 2, dc in next st, **change to Yarn G**, dc 2 in same st, dc 6, (11)

Fasten off leaving tails for sewing.

Sew the detailing onto the mouth. **See fig. 14.**

Get your eyes and place them onto the head with the top in line with R9 and the bottom in line with R16 with a 4 st gap, pin in place and pin the mouth just below the eyes but sitting in line with the 4 st gap. Pin in place and make sure you are happy with the placement. Sew all onto the head. **See fig. 15**

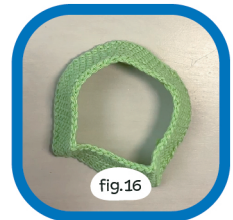


Biteysaurus Mask Top

In Yarn H

1. ch 48, dc in first ch to make a loop and dc around (48)
- 2-3. dc around (48) x 2 rounds
4. (dc 7, inc) x6 (54)
5. (dc 8, inc) x6 (60)
6. dc around (60)
7. (dc 9, inc) x6 (66)

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing. Make two pinches in the piece with a 12st gap between, sew in place to form corners in the mask. **See figs. 16 & 17**



Biteysaurus Mask Bottom

In Yarn H

1. ch 36, dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc 34 (35)
2. dc across (35)

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing. Make 4 pinches in the piece, the first, 4 sts from the start of the piece, the second 7 sts away from the first, the third, 6 sts away from the second, the fourth 7 sts away from the third. I recommend pinning each seam in place so you are happy. **See fig. 18**

Sew in place.

Sew the bottom of the mask to the top with each end 4 sts away from the two seams in the top of the mask. The end of each bottom piece should sit around 2 rows from the bottom of the mask top. **See fig. 19 & 20**





Biteysaurus Mask Sides

In Yarn H

1. dc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Sew to the sides where you sewed the bottom part of the mask to the top, this will neaten this up.

Biteysaurus Mask Details

1. ch 5, htr in 2nd ch from hook, htr 2, dc (4)

Using white felt, cut out two hexagonal shapes for the eyes. Using a glue gun, or needle and thread attach to the top of the mask in the middle, with the top of the eyes overlapping the top of the mask. **See fig. 21.**

Cut out three big teeth for the top of the mask and three smaller teeth for the bottom. Make sure you have included tabs when you cut the teeth out, this will make them easier to attach to the mask. Glue or sew three teeth to the top and three on the bottom. **See fig. 22.**

Draw a dot on each eye for the pupil using a marker.
